

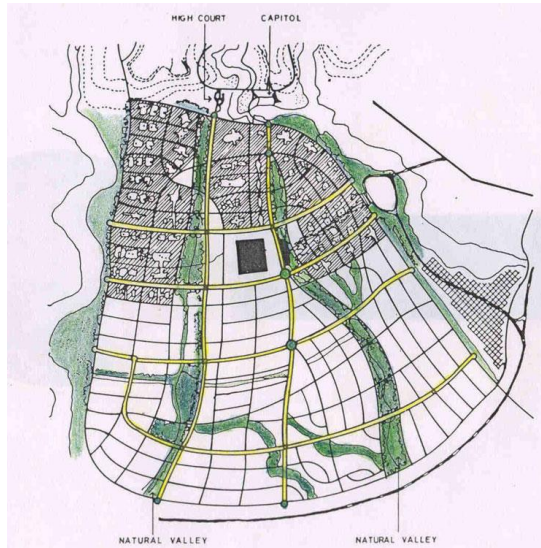
CHANDIGARH- QUICK INTRODUCTION

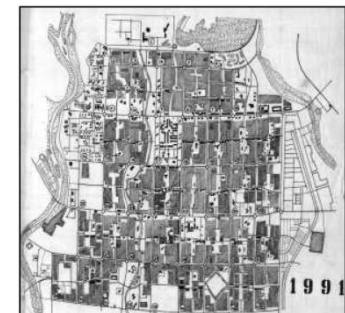

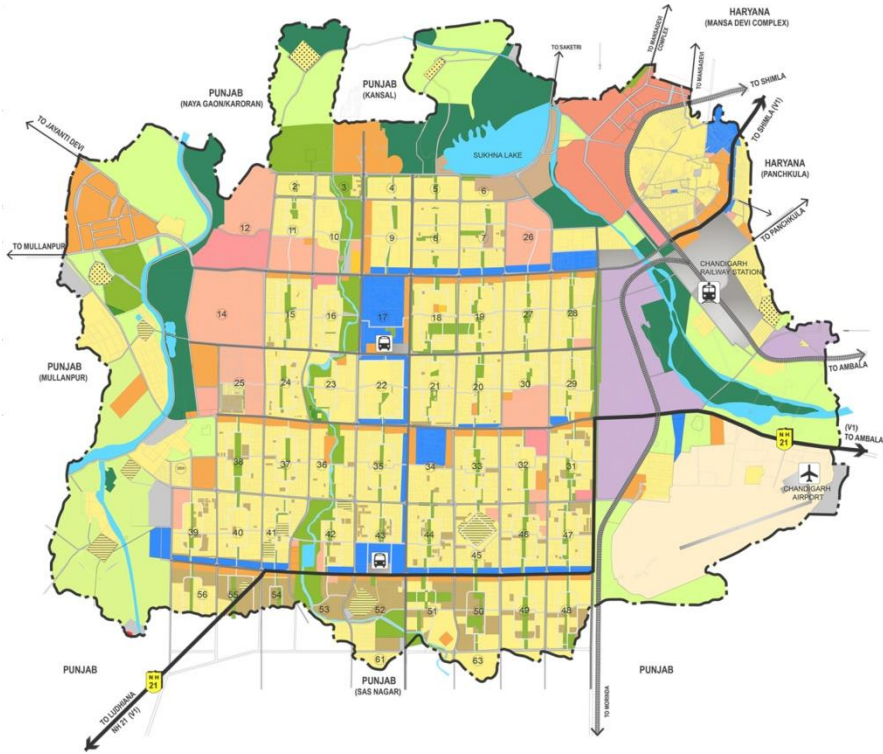

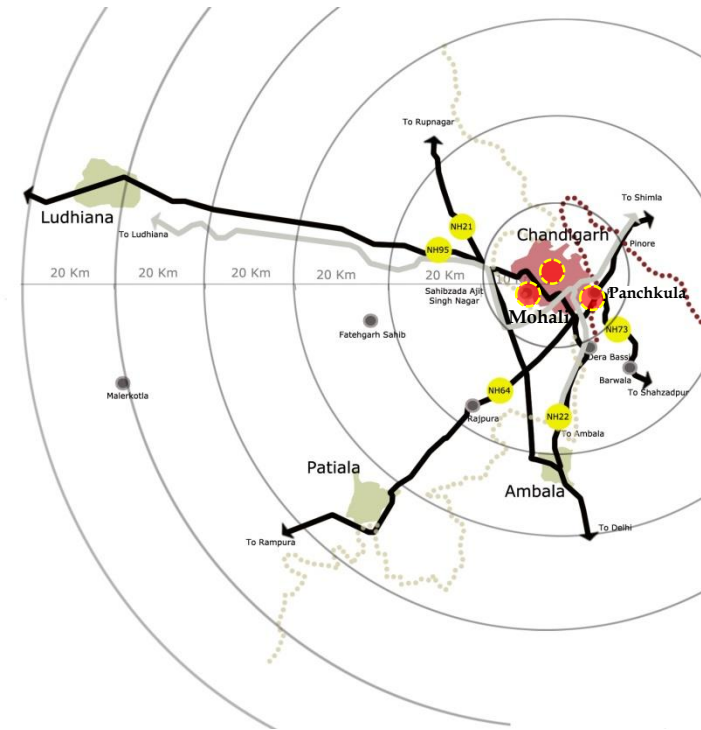

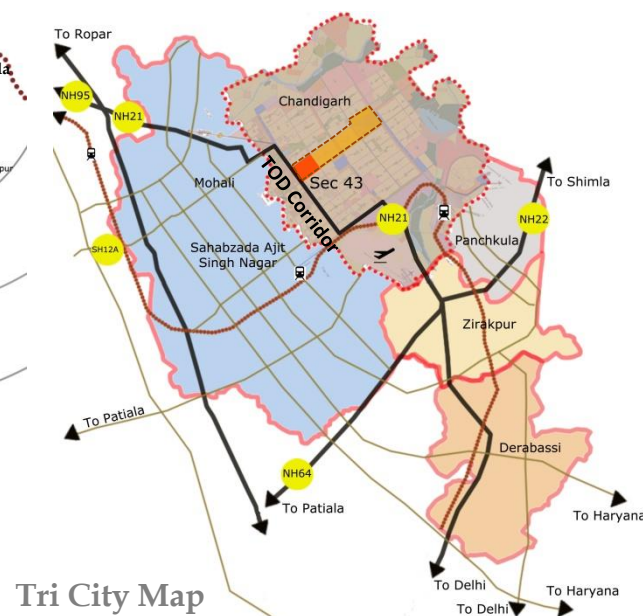

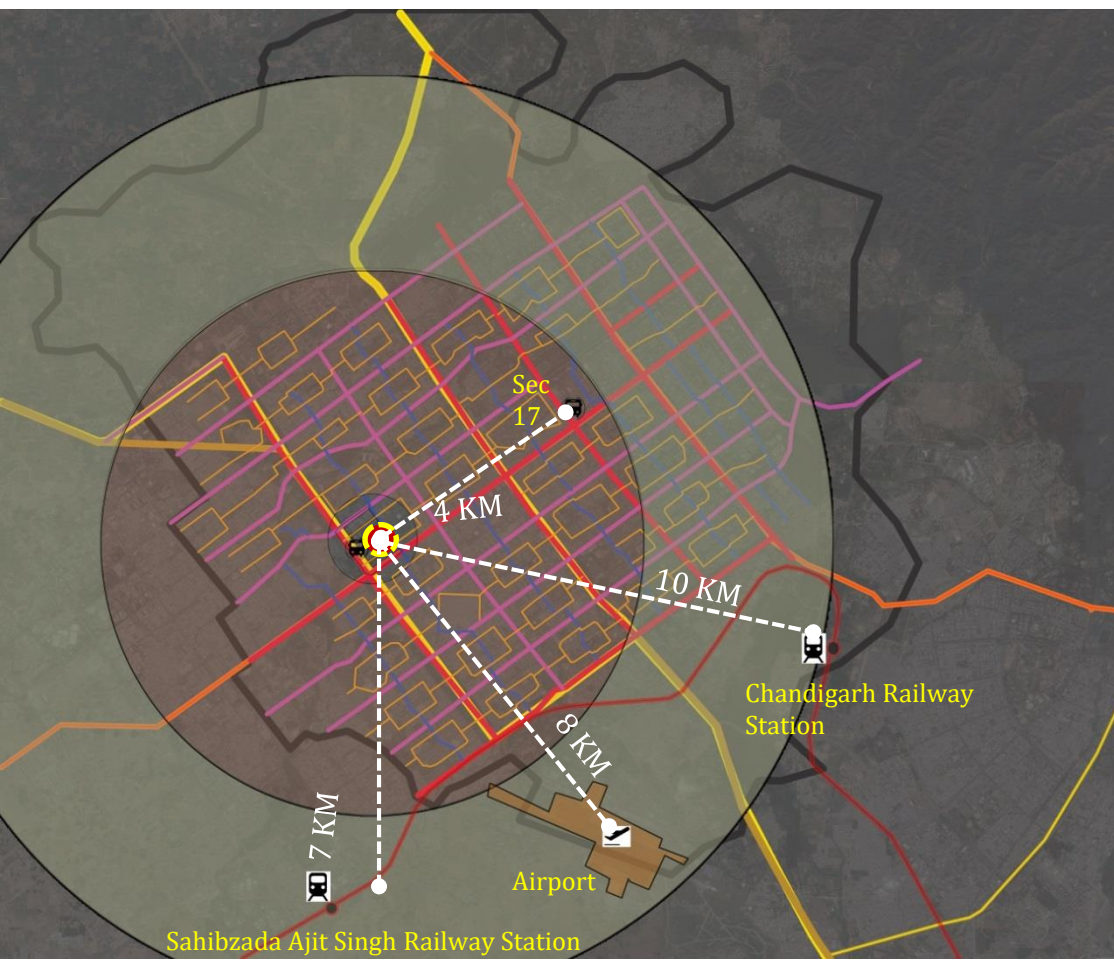
